This is extremely exciting as the MOE awards are the entertainment awards of Australia and lots of famous performers will be there. The date for this is Tuesday the 17th of June. The event is going to be held at Bankstown Sports Club, 8 Greenfield Parade Bankstown. Arrival time is 4.30pm so that the kids can rehearse. The event starts at 7.30pm. The kids will not need to have their hair and make-up done for rehearsal as they can do that in between the rehearsal and the performance. They will need to wear their costumes for rehearsal though so that the lighting can be worked out. Parents can stay and watch but it is standing room only and they have to leave as soon as the dance is finished. The other alternative is to get tickets at \$60 a head which includes a three course meal. Parents can also have pre dinner drinks and canapés at a cost of \$10 a head from 6.30-7.15pm.
